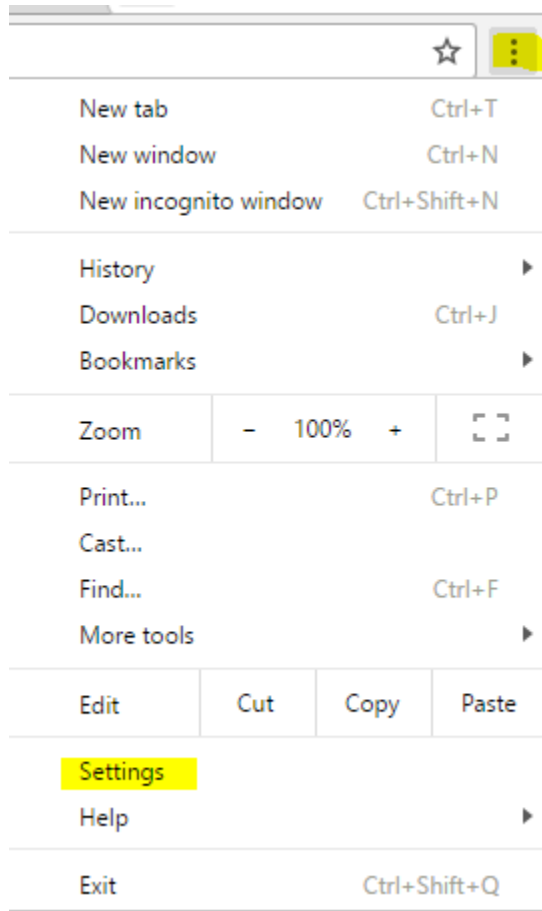

Content settings

Handlers

- Allow sites to ask to become default handlers for protocols (recommended)
- Do not allow any site to handle protocols

Pop-ups

- Allow all sites to show pop-ups
- Do not allow any site to show pop-ups (recommended)

- Allow all sites to track your physical location
- Ask when a site tries to track your physical location (recommended)
