



Public Service Announcement for Water Metering and Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project January Survey Work

In support of the City's initiative to implement a water meter replacement and reading automation program an extensive field survey is being conducted throughout the entire City. A pilot survey study was completed in December to prepare for the system wide survey. Workers will be opening water meter pit lids and if needed remove dirt (possibly by Vactor truck) to examine existing conditions. All work will be conducted outside of the home.

The field survey work will start Wednesday, January 4th and run through the end of the month.

The City will provide customers with additional information about the meter replacement project when the work begins during the first quarter 2017. The City will provide additional newspaper Public Service Announcements (PSA) as needed, Next Door, City Utility Bills as needed, and the City's Website.

Workers will be wearing a uniform shirt and hat with the company name – Concord Utilities Services. The vehicle that they use will also have a sign – Concord Utilities Services. They will also have a picture ID.
