The City of Rio Vista is accepting applications for the position of **Maintenance Worker I**. Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of skilled, semi-skilled and routine duties assigned to classes within the series including constructing, repairing and maintaining City streets, parks, landscaping, airport, pool and water, sewer and building facilities; learns policies, procedures and work methods associated with assigned duties.

This is the entry level class within the Maintenance Worker series. Positions in this classification are responsible for a wide variety of less difficult and complex tasks and receive on-the-job training in the performance of more complex duties. An incumbent may advance to the next higher classification of Maintenance Worker II upon meeting the employment standards for that class and receiving approval of the Department Head. This classification is distinguished from the next higher classification of Maintenance Worker II by the performance of less complex, semi-skilled tasks. Position requires sitting, standing, walking on level and slippery surfaces, reaching, twisting, turning, kneeling, bending, stooping, squatting, grasping and making repetitive hand movements. Serves on Public Works "oncall" rotation, as scheduled. Must possess a Class C California Driver's License.

Compensation & Benefits:

The City of Rio Vista provides an excellent total compensation and benefits package with a 9/80 work schedule. Benefits for this position according to its representation unit, OE3, listed below:

- ♦ **Monthly Base Salary:** \$3,429 – 4,146
- ♦ **Health/Medical Benefits:** Medical through CalPERS, 90% employer paid, employee contributes 10% of the monthly cost of their selected medical plan.
- ♦ **Dental, Vision & Life:** City paid dental, vision and life insurance plans.
- ♦ **Retirement:** The City contracts with California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS), Classic Member: 2% at 55 formula. New Pers Member (PEPRA) 2% at 62 as per AB 340. The City participates in Social Security.
- ♦ **Vacation:** 12 days paid vacation for the first three years of service, maximum 25 days annually after 20 years of service.
- ♦ **Holidays:** 13 paid holidays and 2 paid floating holidays per year.
- ♦ **Sick Leave:** 96 hours
- ♦ **Standby:** \$100 per day
- ♦ **D1-D3 & T1-T3 Certificates:** An additional compensation of \$100 per certificate, per month for up to six (6) certificates.
- ♦ **QAC Certificate:** \$100 per month.

- ♦ **Class B Drivers License:** \$50 per month.
